NIDO advances access to basic services like quality education to the children of parents work in front line conservation. This enables us to enlist their cooperation to reduce poaching activities in protected areas.


NIDO STORIES


My name is Richard Kasadha and I am proud Musoga who grew up in Namutumba with my grandma in Nkolo village.



EDUCATION BURSARIES

Tree Lion & Rhino Conservation

Beneficiaries are communities around Queen Elizabeth National Park and Murchison Falls National Park in Uganda to acquire nursing or other trade skills qualifications. Partnerships in place to help them attend nursing & midwifery, welding, carpentry/joinery, plumbing, motor vehicle mechanic, plus building and brick laying in exchange for supporting wildlife conservation program in the area.

- o 50 recipients
- Nursing Skills
 - CAD \$1650 per pupil/year
- o Other Trade Skills
 - CAD **\$800** per pupil/year

Urban Poverty Intervention Initiative


