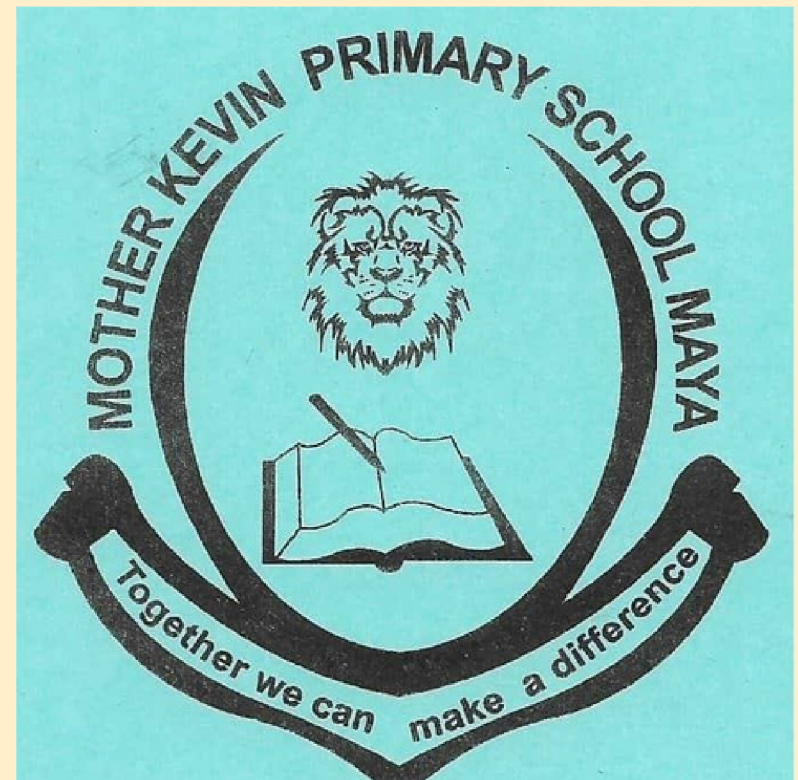

# EDUCATION BURSARIES

## Tree Lion & Rhino Conservation

Beneficiaries are communities around Queen Elizabeth National Park and Murchison Falls National Park in Uganda to acquire nursing or other trade skills qualifications. Partnerships in place to help them attend nursing & midwifery, welding, carpentry/joinery, plumbing, motor vehicle mechanic, plus building and brick laying in exchange for supporting wildlife conservation program in the area.

- **50** recipients
- Nursing Skills
  - CAD **\$1650** per pupil/year
- Other Trade Skills
  - CAD **\$800** per pupil/year

## Urban Poverty Intervention Initiative

Beneficiaries live in extreme urban poverty in Uganda's capital, Kampala. Your financial contribution will cover full tuition for primary, high school, and vocational education. Supervised by a local NIDO partner.

- **50** recipients
- CAD **\$750** per pupil / year

## Primate Conservation Community Partnership

For families in or around Bwindi-Mganinga primate (mountain gorilla) conservation area, covering full tuition for primary, high school, and vocational education in exchange for supporting wildlife conservation programs in the area.

- CAD **\$800** per pupil / year
